Teaching literacy often feels like a balancing act between best practices and instructional time. This session offers a comprehensive research-based literacy program that is responsive, manageable, and meets the needs of diverse students. It provides a clear structure for whole-class lessons, small groups and independent practice in reading, writing and word work that maximizes instructional time while incorporating existing practices. With concrete strategies, “low-floor high-ceiling” activities, and real-life examples, this session will help teachers reach all learners, build a literacy-rich environment, and feel confident that they are making time for it all.



Kristi Cooper is an instructional leader from Kelowna, B.C. with over 20 years of experience in literacy instruction, curriculum design, and teacher coaching. Kristi has worked as an elementary classroom teacher and literacy support teacher and is currently an instructional leader working with K-12 teachers across all subject areas.
