Due to COVID- 19, all public presentations to bills at Standing Committees will take place virtually, using Zoom.

If you are registered to present, you will receive the Zoom link, via a calendar invitation, around 5 p.m. on the day of the Committee meeting. For more information on presenting virtually please click [here](#).
